Petitioner-Amit has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.220 dated 15.08.2015 under Sections 302, 201, 120-B and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Line Paar, Bahadurgarh.

Notice of motion.

Mr.B.S.Virk, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, earlier DDR was got recorded on the statement of Ravi Kumar, who stated that on 10.08.2015, his father Joginder had gone from the house to do labour work but did not return home. On search, his dead body was

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found in the drain on 13.08.2015. It is in the statement that nobody is responsible for the same, nor he want to take any legal action against anyone. His father had fallen in the drain under the influence of alcohol. After two months, Suman, daughter of deceased got recorded her statement by stating that his father had a fight with Amit (present petitioner) etc.

The petitioner has been in custody since 29.10.2015. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
