This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.45 dated 12.08.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Pojewal, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 16.11.2016:-

“It has been inter-alia contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that parties are closely related and a compromise has been effected between them. Moreover, the injury which falls in the ambit of Section 326 IPC is on the little finger of the complainant. Otherwise also, petitioner undertakes to join the investigation and to cooperate with the investigating agency.

Notice of motion for 01.02.2017.

Meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation within seven days from the date of receipt of

certified copy of this order. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on interim bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Avtar Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

That apart, the observations contained in the notice of motion order have gone uncontroverted.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 16.11.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
