ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 48, dated 10.06.2017, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he had taken a sum of Rs.23,72,000/- from the complainant on the pretext of sending his son to America. The son of the complainant was neither sent to America nor the amount was returned. It is also mentioned in the FIR that the matter was compromised between the petitioner and the complainant. A sum of Rs.19,16,000/- was agreed to be returned to the complainant by the petitioner in view of the compromise. However, the petitioner had backed out from the compromise and the cheques issued by the petitioner were also dishonoured.

In view of the seriousness of the aforementioned allegation of having taken large sum of money to send the son of the complainant abroad and the cheques issued by the petitioner in terms of the alleged compromise being dishonoured, I do not deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
