ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.61, dated 19.05.2017, under Sections 379-B/323 of IPC (Section 411 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, six boys having muffled faces came to the petrol pump on their motor cycles and took away cash; two mobile phones; 9 litres Mobil oil and forcibly filled their motorcycles' tanks after giving beating to the complainant- Akhilesh Pandey. He further submits that there is a delay of about 8 days in registration of the FIR. He also states that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the disclosure statement of other accused. The petitioner is in custody for over 04 months.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Amandeep Singh, states that investigation has been completed and challan has been filed in the Court.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for over 04 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Dilpreet Singh @ Kaka is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail in case the petitioner is found involved in any other subsequent case or found misusing concession of bail.
