The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.101 dated 7th September, 2016, registered under Sections 21-61-85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the NDPS Act') at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar Rural.

The petitioner was arrested on 7th September, 2016. Out of the items recovered from him the only contraband covered under the NDPS Act happens to be 8 glass injections of 2 ml. each, containing Buprenorphine Hydrochloride which comes to a total of 16 ml., which is admittedly below the commercial quantity.

There is no record of the petitioner's involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act.

As such considering the long detention undergone by the present petitioner, namely Gurbaj Singh @ Baj, he may be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate concerned.
