Petitioner seeks a direction to the official respondents not to compel the petitioner to marry respondent no.9.

It is submitted that the petitioner and respondent no.9 had friendly relations. However, when the petitioner came to know that respondent no.9 is a married lady having one child, he stopped meeting the complainant and stopped taking her calls as well. The petitioner is a young man and he does not wish to marry respondent no.9. A complaint was submitted by respondent no.9, which is not on the record of this file. Subsequent thereto, it is submitted that the petitioner was pressurized by the police officials due to which he entered into a compromise with respondent no.9. Pursuant to the said compromise, respondent no.9 suffered a statement (Annexure P-2), whereby she withdrew her complaint on the basis of the offer extended by the petitioner to get married to her. It is submitted that the

petitioner is being blackmailed by the complainant and the police officials, though no specific allegation has been raised against any particular official in the petition. ₹ 25,000/- is also alleged to have been taken from the petitioner, though there are no specific details as to which person took the money from him. Neither is there anything on record to reveal that the petitioner at any point of time protested against any such harassment etc. meted out to him by any of the police officials.

Consequently, finding no ground to interfere in exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C, this petition is dismissed. Petitioner is however, at liberty to seek remedy/ remedies as may be available to him.
