The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 356 dated 26.09.2016, under Sections 10 and 7-A of Haryana Development and Regulation of Urban Areas Act, 1975, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had sold his agricultural land measuring 04 kanals 10 marlas after sub dividing into plots for residential purposes without obtaining a license under Section 3 of the Haryana Development and Regulation of Urban Areas Act, 1975. He further contends that although the plots were sold before March, 2012, the FIR has been lodged after four years in the year 2016 which is barred by the limitation prescribed under Section 468 of the Cr.P.C.

This Court vide order dated 13.10.2017, had directed

the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Chandan Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 13.10.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 13.10.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
