Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.398 dated 16.08.2017 registered under Sections 341, 380, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25,27,54,59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar, on the basis of compromise (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 23.10.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Chief

Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, on 13.11.2017 and got recorded their

statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide letter bearing No.1265 dated 13.11.2017.

According to the report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, the parties have willfully settled their differences and arrived at bona fide compromise without any pressure and the same seems to be genuine.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.398, is quashed qua the petitioners.
