INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty and to provide adequate security to protect them from respondents No.4 and 5, who are parents of petitioner No.1. The petitioners, who are present in Court today, further contend that they being major have solemnized marriage with their own consent in accordance with law. The private respondents are not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and are extending threats to them. Affidavit of petitioner No.1 (Annexure P/1), copy of 'Aadhaar' card of petitioner No.2 (Annexure P/2) and marriage photographs (Annexure P-3) have been placed on record.

Heard.

Respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Jind, is directed to look into the representation dated 12.10.2017 (Annexure P/4), moved by the petitioners as per law. He is also directed to verify the fact with regard to the age of petitioner No.1 and if she is found to be less than 18 years, then he is

at liberty to take necessary action as per law.

With aforesaid directions, this petition stands disposed of.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
