Heard.

The perusal of reply shows that the information has been collected from BSNL, Bank of India, ICICI Bank and State Bank of India, but the addresses mentioned in bank accounts and in identity proofs were found to be fake. Therefore, the culprits are not traced so far. The police is making efforts to trace out the culprits. The Cyber Crime Cell, Mohali, is also investigating the matter, which is specialized branch of Punjab Police.

It being so, there is no need to transfer the investigation to any other agency. Punjab State Cyber Crime Branch is directed to complete the investigation expeditiously and not later than six months and present the final report before the concerned Court.
