DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioners seek the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 27, dated 13.04.2016, registered under Section 306 IPC, at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 10.11.2016, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had granted the concession of ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Whether the petitioners have abetted the deceased to commit suicide, is an issue which is debatable and would be decided only during the trial. Even otherwise, the petitioners have joined investigation and no recovery is to be made from them.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not needed by the investigating agency.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 10.11.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
