Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.16 dated 11.09.2017 under Section 7, 13(2) of the P.C. Act, registered at Police Station V.B. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Counsel for the petitioner states that he has been arrested on 11.09.2017.

Learned counsel for the State submits that there is no other case against the petitioner and the challan has not yet been presented.

In view of the fact that there is no other case pending against the petitioner of the similar nature, I think the petitioner should be allowed the benefit of bail.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall file undertaking

before the trial Court that he will not indulge in similar or any other kind of offence in future. Petitioner shall deposit his passport with the trial Court. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposed the petition for regular bail.
