Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all material witnesses have been examined in the trial on going, and this Court vide its order dated 23.10.2017 passed in CWP No.12661 of 2017, admitted co-accused of the petitioner to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court, as the trial is still ongoing with 17 witnesses still to be examined, with the present petitioner and those who were granted bail on that date, having continued to have remained in custody for about 1 year and 4 months.

Learned State counsel does not deny the factual position which is also very fairly not denied by the learned counsel for the complainant, who otherwise opposes the bail application.

Consequently, with the direction to the trial Court repeated to conclude the trial by mid-January 2018, this petition is allowed and the petitioner-Raman Kumar is ordered to be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of that Court.
