KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 12.10.2017. The true typed copy of mark sheet of secondary examination (*Annexure P-1*) of the petitioner No. 1 wherein passing year of secondary examination has been mentioned. In support of her date of birth proof, an affidavit (*Annexure P-2*) of petitioner No. 1 has also been placed in the file. The true typed copy of Adhar Card of petitioner No. 2, issued by the Government of India, showing his date of birth has been placed on file as (*Annexure P-3*). The marriage certificate of their marriage has been placed on file as (*Annexure P-4*) and the photographs of their marriage have been placed on file (*Annexure P-5*).

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 12.10.2017 (*Annexure P-6*) before the police authorities for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Ambala, to consider the application of the petitioners dated 12.10.2017 (*Annexure P-6*) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that

there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect their life and liberty. However, this order shall not be construed as recognition of valid marriage between the parties.

The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
