The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.249 dated 22.11.2014 under Sections 323/324/341/506/148/149 registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between the parties in which only simple injuries were caused and the matter has now been compromised.

This Court by the order dated 02.11.2017, had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS

Mohali, has sent his report dated 16.11.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between the parties, which has now been resolved. The injuries are simple in nature.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.249 dated 22.11.2014 under Sections 323/324/341/506/148/149 registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
