SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, namely, Varun Anand, in case FIR No. 124, dated 10.04.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420, 408, 120-B IPC and 66, 66C, 66D of Information Technology Act 2000, at Police Station Udyog Vihar, District Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and he has not made any disclosure statement at any point of time. More so, he is in custody since 23.08.2016 and the trial will take some time to conclude, therefore, the petitioner be released on regular bail. He further submitted that co-accused has already been released on regular bail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant opposed the bail petition on the ground that no case is made out for the petitioner to release on bail.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties; the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 23.08.2016; co-accused has already been granted the concession of bail; there is no other case against the present petitioner and the fact that the trial is still to take some time, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Gurgaon (Gurugram).

Nothing said here-in-above shall be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
