Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.215 dated 10.09.2017 under Sections 323, 452, 380, 148, 149 of IPC (Section 324 of IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

Memorandum of appearance filed on behalf of complainant in court today, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 24.10.2017 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the petitioners have taken away a buffalo and a cow of the complainant. Learned State

counsel joined hand with the complainant.

Considering the fact that whether the buffalo and cow were actually taken away, is required to be adjudicated during trial, the order dated 24.10.2017 whereby the petitioners were admitted on ad-interim bail by this Court, is made absolute.

Accordingly, present petition is allowed.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
