During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner Mr. Ashwani Talwar, Advocate has made a statement that as per the instructions received by him, since the petitioner has already lost valuable time in pursuing the present matter before this Court, he withdraws the present petition without prejudice to his complaint before the trial Court on merits but has made a fervent prayer that the petitioner has reservations over the words '*direction that learned trial Court would record further preliminary evidence if any and then to pass the order in the light of report under Section 202 Cr.P.C. as per law*'.

As prayed, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. However, in the light of submissions made and in the interests of justice, right vests in the petitioner/complainant, if he wishes/desirous of leading preliminary evidence further, he is at liberty to do so else he may close the same at the stage where the evidence has been recorded as on date before the concerned Court. However, having regard to the fact that the complaint was initially filed way back in the year 2007 and almost ten years have passed and the complainant is eluded justice, impels this Court to issue necessary directions to the trial Court to ensure speedy disposal by giving short adjournments and to ensure that the matter stands completely adjudicated and disposed off within a period of 8 months from the date parties put in appearance before it.

The parties are directed to put in appearance before the trial Court. Records be sent back immediately.
