Petitioner seeks the benefit of regular bail in case F.I.R. No.0060 dated 06.07.2016 under sections 20, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the present petitioner as also co-accused is of 4 bags of Ganja, 10 kgs. each i.e. 40 kgs. in all.

The alleged recovery would be construed as commercial quantity.

This Court would not be inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner the benefit of regular bail in view of the bar envisaged under Section 37 of N.D.P.S Act.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
