Petitioners-Sewak Singh, Sukhwinder @ Sukha, Neelam @ Lali and Pooja Rani have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.360 dated 26.05.2016, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Vide order dated 16.11.2016 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, petitioner Nos.1 and 2 namely Sewak Singh and Sukhwinder @ Sukha have already been granted bail. Now this petition remains only qua petitioner Nos.3 and 4 namely Neelam @ Lali and Pooja Rani.

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Notice of motion has been issued qua petitioner Nos.3 and 4. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for petitioner Nos.3 and 4 as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, deceased-Subhash Chander was married with Pooja about 10-11 years back and he used to reside in his in-laws family. At about 2-3 days earlier of the occurrence, he came from his in-laws family and told the complainant that his wife-Pooja, her mother-Neelam @ Lali and her brother-Deepu harassed her by compelling to live in the matrimonial house. On the day of occurrence, the deceased went to search for the labour work, but he could find same and then at about 1.00 P.M, he committed suicide by hanging himself.

Petitioner Nos.3 and 4 have been in custody since 26.06.2016. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping petitioner Nos.3 and 4 in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed qua petitioner Nos.3 and 4 and they are

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ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- each with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
