The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.96 dated 26.08.2017 under Sections 323/324/326/341/506/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhand, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury is attributed to the petitioner.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 17.10.2017, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar, states that in pursuance to the order dated 17.10.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 17.10.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
