Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has since joined the investigation and no recovery is to be effected from him. Furthermore, the injury attributed to him is simple in nature although location of the injury is on the head and the weapon used allegedly a sharp edged one.

Learned State counsel concedes this fact on instructions from HC Jaswant Singh, Police Station Kotwali, Kapurthala. He further states that since the recovery of weapon has been effected, the petitioner is not required by the Police for further custodial investigation.

In the light of above circumstances, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.10.2017 is made absolute subject to conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
