AVNEESH JHINGAN, J.

1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6. The petitioners contend that they being major, have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. They further submit that respondents No. 4 to 6 are not accepting their marriage and adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. They further submit that in view of the imminent danger to their life and liberty they have already moved a representation dated 14.10.2017 (Annexure P-5) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh.

2. Keeping in view the seriousness of the matter, but without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh, to take action as warranted by law on the representation moved by the petitioners and in the meantime to issue necessary orders to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6.

3. It is made clear that in case any FIR is registered against husband, it will be open for the police authorities to take action in accordance with law.
