Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the serious injuries caused to the petitioner, as contended, at the hands of respondent no.5 and other accused, the police has completely exonerated respondent no.5 and even as regards respondents no.6 to 10, no offence under Section 307 IPC has been added by the police, despite the fact that the petitioner being 73 years old, the accumulation of the injuries would, according to him, be dangerous to life.

Without making any comment whatsoever on the merit of the contention, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural (respondent no.3), to look into the grievance of the petitioner and to take appropriate action as per law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
