Petitioners are present in Court.

It is stated that the petitioners have married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 to 7. Petitioners seek protection to their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life.

Petitioners have already submitted a representation copy whereof has been annexed as Annexure P-5.

Respondent No.2 to look into the representation and decide the same within a period of one month.

In the meantime, respondent Nos.2 and 3 are directed to ensure the protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Needless to say that this Court has not opined about the validity of the marriage as the order is being passed only on the basis of assertions made in the petition.

If the petitioners are involved in any criminal case, this order would not come in the way of the authorities to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Hence, this present petition is disposed of.
