Petitioners are present in Court duly identified by their counsel.

Petitioners assert that they have married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 and 5. Petitioners have submitted a representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala.

Petitioners apprehend danger to their life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Taking into consideration, the assertions made in the petition, the present petition is disposed of by giving a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the representation.

Respondent Nos.2 and 3 are directed to ensure protection to life and liberty of the petitioners.

Needless to say that this Court has not opined the validity of the marriage.

If the petitioners are involved in any criminal case, this order would not come in the way of the authorities to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Hence, this present petition is disposed of.
