FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case registered by way of FIR No.122 dated 12.08.2017 at Police Station Barara, District Ambala, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of orders of interim bail dated 20.10.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Veerbhan, Police Station Barara District Ambala who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute, though Mr. N.S.Shekhawat, Advocate learned counsel for the complainant sought to oppose the same on the grounds of being the principal accused which is

controverted by learned counsel for the petitioner and is also readily acceded to by the prosecution as well as the counsel for the petitioner, though learned counsel for the complainant sought to rake up the plea that only simple injuries are attributed.

However, keeping in view the stand of the Investigating Officer and the stand of the State, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.10.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.(challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
