LISA GILL, J.

This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 208 dated 26.12.2013 (**Annexure P-1**) registered under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' for short) at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga on the basis of a compromise dated 22.09.2015 (**Annexure P-2**) arrived at between the parties.

According to the settlement, the parties i.e. petitioner No.1 and respondent No. 2 decided to bury the hatchet and live with each other in their matrimonial home. However, during the pendency of this petition, it is submitted that the settlement between the parties has fallen through. The matter was placed before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court as well. However, mediation between the parties failed. An effort was made by this Court as well to try and resolve the dispute between the parties but at this stage there appears to be no possibility of an amicable settlement of the dispute.

In view of the position as above, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw this petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
