Petitioner-Maninder Singh Dhaliwal has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.169 dated 19.08.2017, registered at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, under Sections 364, 323, 341, 342, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that as per the allegations, the present petitioner alongwith co-accused, who are also studying in the same college, took away the complainant and confined him in some room. It is also alleged that later on, the complainant was left to go. There is also allegation that some beatings have been given.

Learned State counsel has brought into notice of this Court that there is no MLR showing any injury.

The petitioner has been in custody since 07.09.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case. Furthermore, the occurrence took place on 10.08.2017 and the present FIR has been registered on 19.08.2017 i.e. after a delay of 09 days.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
