Applicant-petitioner is permitted to place on record the statements of the first six prosecution witnesses examined in the Ld. Trial Court Annexure P-7 to P-12.

CRM-M-39593-2017

This is a petition under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. praying for regular bail of the petitioner in connection with FIR No.51, dated 13.06.2017, under Sections 307, 34 of the IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act and Sections 61/1/14 of the Excise Act, registered at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda. The petitioner has remained in custody for more than six months now.

From the statements given before the Ld. Trial Court by all the private witnesses cited in the case including the complainant, it transpires

that no incriminating statement has come forth against the petitioner.

In the circumstances, therefore, his further detention for an indefinite period is not justified and he is, therefore, ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court, who shall be at liberty to cancel the same in the event of any incriminating material subsequently transpired against him.
