Vide an order of this Court dated 11.11.2016, it had been directed that upon the petitioners appearing before the trial Court and furnishing their bail bonds and surety bonds, they would be released on interim bail by that Court.

However till February 02, 2017 it had not been made clear as to whether the petitioners had appeared before that Court and had been admitted to bail or not.

A report from the trial Court had been called for which has been received, wherein it has been stated by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Fatehabad, that “the petitioners Taqdeer Singh and Kuldeep Singh appeared before the Court on 21.11.2016 and were ordered to be released on regular bail”.

Consequently, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that this petition, seeking anticipatory bail, no longer survives.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
