This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the respondents to complete the investigation and submit the final report in FIR No.109 dated 31.03.2017 registered at Police Station Farakpur under Section 420 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer only that the official respondents may be directed to complete the investigation expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kuldeep Sharma, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned State counsel has no objection to the prayer of the petitioner.

Perusal of the record shows that the FIR has been registered on 31.03.2017 under Section 420 IPC i.e. about 7 months earlier, but the investigation has not been completed so far.

In view of the above said fact, the official respondents are directed to expedite the completion of investigation and submit the final report expeditiously.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
