The present petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking protection to their life and liberty which according to them was under threat on account of their having getting married against the wishes of their relatives.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as on date the petitioners have not received any threat calls from the private respondents and, therefore, the petitioners do not apprehend any danger to their life and liberty. He, however, seeks liberty to file a fresh petition for the same relief in case of any subsequent threat to life and liberty of the petitioners.

In view of the above statement, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. However, in case of any subsequent threat to their life and liberty, the petitioners are granted liberty to again approach this Court by filing a fresh petition for the same relief.
