ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No. 53 dated 03.06.2011, under Sections 387, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 12.03.2015 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an outcome of misunderstanding between the petitioner and daughter of respondent No. 2. The matter has now been compromised between the parties.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 15.11.2016 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court for recording their statements with regard to the

genuineness of compromise. The report of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dasuya, dated 22.12.2016 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded, which indicates that they have entered into compromise voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of misunderstanding between the petitioner and daughter of respondent No. 2. Now the matter has been compromised and the parties want to live in peace and harmony.

In view of the law laid down in "*Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab*" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 53 dated 03.06.2011, under Sections 387, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner only.
