According to the status report dated 30.10.2016 lying on record, the police has prepared a cancellation report in the case, but the same has to be presented accompanying the complainant.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State contends that the complainant is not co-operating with the Investigating Officer, inasmuch as he is not accompanying the Investigating Officer to submit the cancellation report in the Court.

In view of above, the Investigating Officer is hereby directed to issue a written notice to the complainant to appear on a particular date in the Court of Illaqa Magistrate, on which he would submit the cancellation report or in the alternative, to issue a notice in writing to the complainant to accompany him to the Court of Illaqa Magistrate, while he will go for presentation of the cancellation report. The complainant shall comply with

the notice of the Investigating Officer and would accompany him to the Court.

Since nothing survives in this petition, inasmuch as according to the F.S.L. report, no poisonous substance was found to have been administered to deceased Gurbrinder Singh, son of the complainant, therefore, this petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to adopt legal recourse that may be available to him under the statute.

The petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
