The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.288 dated 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2017, registered under Sections 379-B, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

It transpires that cross-examination of the complainant in the Ld. Trial Court has been completed.
