The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.57 dated 10.08.2016 for the offence under Sections 506/34 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Women, Panipat.

Learned counsel for the State is not disputing the fact that before the trial Court prosecutrix and her sister have turned hostile and this fact is evident from certified copy of their statements.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that trial is likely to take time for its own conclusion, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing their fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate, Panipat.
