This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of the order dated 18.11.2015, passed by the JMIC, Jalandhar, by which the petitioners herein have been declared as proclaimed offenders in case bearing No. CHI/64/2015 titled as ***State of Punjab vs. Tarun Kumar & Anr.*** arising out of FIR No. 51 dated 13.06.2013, registered under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

A petition bearing ***CRM-M-41270-2017*** has also been filed by the petitioners herein for quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of the compromise entered into between the parties, wherein, by an order dated 03.11.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording of their statements regarding the genuineness of the compromise. In pursuance of the direction, a report has

been received from JMIC at Jalandhar, stating that the compromise arrived at between the parties is without any pressure or coercion from any one and the same appears to be genuine one. Hence, Vide order of the even date passed in **CRM-M-41270-2017**, the FIR in question along with all subsequent proceedings has been quashed by this Court qua the petitioners herein.

Since the FIR in question itself has been quashed by this Court qua the petitioners herein, the order dated 18.11.2015, passed by the JMIC, Jalandhar, by which the petitioners herein have been declared as proclaimed offenders, is also quashed.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
