This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.99 dated 26.05.2015 registered under Sections 452/324/323/148/149 and 427 IPC(challan present under Sections 323/324/326/427 and 34 IPC), at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar, on the basis of compromise dated 05.02.2016 (Annexure P2) arrived at between the parties.

Vide order dated 09.03.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court, for getting their statements recorded. In compliance thereof, learned trial Court has submitted its report dated 11.04.2017 which *inter alia* stipulates that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine and based on free will and consent of the parties.

In view of the above, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and that is not only for the betterment of warring groups, but a semblance for the growth of society. Consequently, this Court is satisfied that it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR as well as proceedings resulting therefrom.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. FIR No.99 dated 26.05.2015 registered under Sections 452/324/323/148/149 and 427 IPC(challan present under Sections 323/324/326/427 and 34 IPC), at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar alongwith all consequential proceedings are quashed.
