Allegations are of firing on the police party when S.T.F raided the house of the petitioner. Petitioner is a proclaimed offender and is involved in many heinous offences as per police record. Petitioner is also alleged to have been involved in gang war activities. One Swaran Singh was apprehended on the spot whereas petitioner succeeded in fleeing away from there. One pistol and live cartridges were recovered from Swaran Singh and one pistol was recovered from the vehicle.

In view of aforesaid, this Court does not feel that the petitioner is entitled to any concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
