The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.75 dated 28.08.2016, under Sections 304-B, 316 of the Indian Penal Code (in alternate under Section 302 of IPC), registered at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has appeared before the trial court and released on interim bail.

Learned DAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions from Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has appeared before the trial court and released on interim bail.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for

custodial interrogation and has appeared before the trial court and released on interim bail, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 26.10.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
