FATEH DEEP SINGH J.(Oral)

The allegations against the petitioner Jagrdeep Singh @ Laddi in the present regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.164 dated 25.7.2016, under Sections 364, 323, 436, 379-B, 506, 120-B, 148 and 149 IPC, P.S. Nathana, Bathinda, are that he was having illicit relationship with Komal wife of Vijay Kumar and that on 23.7.2016 while Vijay Kumar @ Vicky was coming from Village Tapa, he received threatening telephonic call from the petitioner and in the area of Village Chak Fateh Singh Wala was stopped by the petitioner-accused alongwith other 4-5 unidentified persons and in the process kidnapped Vijay Kumar @ Vicky.

The contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner are that the petitioner is behind the bars since 30.4.2017 and that only simple injuries have been attributed and prima facie no allegations under Sections 364 and 379-B are made out and that it is a case of amorous relationship between grown up persons and that he has been falsely implicated.

Though learned State counsel has sought to oppose the grant of bail to the petitioner on the ground of heinousness of offence and seriousness of allegations.

Appreciating the submissions and that it is at the most a case of relationship between a grown up lady and a male and that so far as Section 364 IPC is concerned, culpability of which, if any, shall be determined during the trial. Keeping in view the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner and the fact that the trial will take a long time to conclude, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner in the present case is unwarranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
