RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that the allegations forming subject matter of complaint are divided into two parts. First part related to incident which allegedly took place on 26.06.2014 in which utterances were made to the caste of the complainant. Thereafter, on 28.06.2014, the accused besides using derogatory words also inflicted injuries to the

complainant.

Recital of the complaint in terms of paras No.3 and 5 only shows that a formal complaint was made on 24.07.2014 and thereafter, the complaint came to be filed in the Court on 27.10.2016. The conduct of the parties in the context of earlier FIR No.43 dated 21.02.2007 under Section 377 IPC has prima-facie connectivity in the context of filing the present complaint.

Petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court on or before the date fixed. In the event of their appearance, they shall be admitted to bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court. The petitioners shall keep on appearing on each and every date.
