This is a petition filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.116 dated 06.08.2017, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC and Section 3(1) SC/ST Act, at Police Station Sadar, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana.

This Court had passed an order dated 26.10.2017, rejecting *ad interim* prayer for the offence under SC/ST Act.

Thereafter on 30.11.2017, learned counsel for the petitioner offered to pay compensation amount to the complainant in the sum of Rs.25,000/-.

I have perused the allegations in the FIR and I do not think that the matter should be stretched any further. In my view, payment

of compensation to the complainant should be made in the interest of justice.

The petitioner has accordingly deposited Rs.25,000/- to the Registry of this Court vide Receipt No.2096 dated 04.12.2017.

Registry is directed to transfer the amount of Rs.25,000/- to Tehsildar, Bilaspur, District Yamunanagar, who shall, within a period of 15 days after the receipt of the amount from the Registry of this Court, make payment thereof to the complainant-Yogesh Kumar S/o Bahadur Singh, R/o Village Tehi Jatana, District Yamunanagar, by personally visiting the Village where the complainant resides and after doing the needful, send acknowledgment to the Registry of this Court.

In view of the above, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the aforesaid FIR No.116 dated 06.08.2017, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC and Section 3 (1) SC/ST Act, at Police Station Sadar, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana.

Hence, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on *ad interim* anticipatory bail in FIR No.116 dated 06.08.2017, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC and Section 3 (1) SC/ST Act, at Police Station Sadar, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana, on furnishing of his bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. Petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when required and fully cooperate with the Investigating/Arresting Officer. Petitioner

shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Petition disposed of.
