Cancellation of bail order dated 21.10.2016 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana has been sought on the ground that the private respondents have forged certain bills/invoices relating to the transaction between complainant and accused party. The matter was duly considered in detail by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana while allowing the application seeking anticipatory bail by the private respondents. The original bills were produced before the Court with the allegations that the Investigating Officer had refused to issue receipts of the aforesaid documents. A direction was given to the Ahlmad of the Court to hand over the aforesaid original bills to the Investigating Officer under proper receipts after placing the photocopy of

the same on the file.

On perusal of the order passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, the point raised by learned counsel for the petitioner was duly considered while granting the bail and there is no reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge what to talk of issuing notice of motion to consider cancellation of bail.

This petition has no merit.

Dismissed.
