The respondent has been served but has not turned up.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has since appeared in the trial Court and has been released on interim bail. The petitioner had been summoned in a complaint case for various offences under IPC as well as under Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989. It is a matter of trial as to whether such offence is made out or not. Under the circumstances, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 26.10.2017 is made absolute subject to the following conditions :-

- (i) He shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing.
- (ii) He shall not give any threat or intimidation to the

prosecution witnesses.

- (iii) He shall not leave India without prior permission
of the Court.

In addition to that the trial Court may impose any term and condition found suitable to ensure that the petitioner does not abscond and interfere in the trial.

In case the petitioner violates any term and condition on which the bail has been granted to him, the prosecution would be entitled to apply for cancellation of bail.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
