The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 43 dated 10.06.2017, under Sections 307, 212, 216, 473 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in the FIR it is alleged that Ravinder Singh was apprehended along with a stolen vehicle at a special Naka. He had fired at the police party and when the police party returned fire, he was injured and from his personal search .32 bore pistol along with three live and three used cartridges were recovered. On the disclosure statement of Ravinder Singh, the petitioner was apprehended on the next day and a stolen Honda City car was recovered from the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been in custody for over 04 months and the investigation has

completed.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate of the petitioner, which is taken on record. He upon instructions from ASI Surjan Singh states that the investigation has been completed, challan has been filed in the Court and charges have been framed.

Heard.

The petitioner is in custody for over 04 months since the date of arrest on 12.06.2017. Only a stolen Car was allegedly recovered from the petitioner. The conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime. It would be appropriate if the petitioner is granted the concession of regular bail.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Jagroop Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
