Prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Hitesh Sharma in a case arising from FIR No.211 dated 18.06.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 324, 325, 326, 427, 452, 506 IPC and 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Madlauda, District Panipat.

According to prosecution, petitioner-Hitesh Sharma gave slaps and fist blows to complainant-Bijender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner is in custody since 27th July, 2017. No specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner. Final report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented in the Court. No recovery has to be effected from the petitioner. The conclusion of the trial shall take long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any more in jail.

Considering over-all facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
