Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for amendment in the petition so as to incorporate Section 392 IPC in the head-note as well as in the prayer clause.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that after filing the present petition, Section 392 IPC was added and in that circumstances, it has become necessary to file application seeking amendment in the head-note as well as in the prayer clause of the petition.

For the reasons stated in the application, amendment in the head-note as well as in prayer clause so as to add Section 392 IPC, is allowed.

CRM stands disposed of.

CRM-M-40030-2017 (O&M)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.164 dated 13.08.2017 under Sections 379-B, 323, 392, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 19.08.2017 and challan in this case has been presented. In this manner, trial will take sufficient long time.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Balkar Singh states that allegations against the petitioner are serious. Moreover, another case is pending against him for having possession of 12 gms. smack under the NDPS Act. He is on bail in that case.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 19.08.2017, coupled with the fact that trial in the case may take long time, I deem it appropriate to release him on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
