Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.18, dated 23.01.2016, registered under Sections 417, 418, 420, 506 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, Ambala Cantt. District Ambala.

Vide order dated 17.01.2017, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had ordered that in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Sukhbir Singh submits that the investigation done so far has found the petitioner to be innocent.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 17.01.2017 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made
